

PFAS Weekly Update to LHD Advisory Committee 3/30/18

MPART update

- Scientific Advisory Group announced 3/29/18.
- DEQ planning community outreach for Selfridge (20 homes) and Kellogg Air National Guard Base (about 60 homes). DEQ PFAS testing at sites to be done end of April.
- Ford International Airport
 - DEQ assessing foam on tributary near airport
 - State of Michigan will provide guidance to airport under part 201.
 - No known PFAS sites on airport property
 - If individuals have questions about testing, they should contact the airport.
 - Fire department has history of multiple trainings at the airport using AFFF.
- Call last night with Wurtsmith NOW group.
- Carol had conversation with Sen. Stamas regarding opportunities in federal budget for remediation at military sites.
- State Fire Marshal announced 3/29/18 initiation of inventory of firefighting foam (how much, age of foam, and type)

Local Health Department Updates

- Orlando Todd met with Price Pullins regarding mental health needs for Oscoda residents. Will discuss potential to make this available for all sites.

- Participants wanted to ask Carol questions.
 - Why is it taking so long?
 - When will Air Force stop PFAS moving to the lake?
 - Carol noted that funds are available in federal Department of Defense budget for health study at 8 military sites. Criteria for selection of sites is not known.
