District Health Department No. 2 Provides Update on COVID-19 Efforts

District Health Department No. 2 (DHD2), serving Alcona, Iosco, Ogemaw, and Oscoda Counties, would like to take the opportunity to update area residents on the status of COVID-19 vaccinations given by DHD2 in the jurisdiction. To date, a total of 3,712 first doses have been administered by DHD2, with 1,343 second doses being administered as well. Additionally, DHD2 has distributed 2,268 doses to local partners.

As DHD2 continues to move forward in the mass vaccination process, additional clinics are being planned as vaccines become available. If you would like to pre-register for up-coming mass vaccination clinics, go to the DHD2 website at www.dhd2.org and click on the red banner, complete the form in its entirety providing all the necessary information. You will know your form submission is successful when you receive the “Thank You” message after hitting the submit button. IT IS IMPORTANT to note that completing the form is a pre-registration. This does not register you for a particular clinic. DHD2 staff are reaching out to individuals via phone call when an appointment date and time become available. It is crucial that individuals do not show up to a clinic if they are not given a specific appointment date and time. If you are elderly and unable to pre-register on-line, please call the Region 9 Area Agency on Aging for assistance at 989-358-4899. Please note these services are for those ages 65 and up only and this is just to pre-register, not schedule an appointment.

District Health Department No. 2 has also updated their COVID-19 Data Dashboard to include daily new cases by county as well as the number of COVID-19 vaccinations administered by DHD2. The dashboard can be found at www.dhd2.org/covid-19.

In addition, DHD2 now has KN95 masks that are available to the public at no cost. Residents who are interested in obtaining masks can stop by any of the DHD2 office locations during normal business hours.
