

### **DHD2 Septic and Well Pre-Site Visit REQUIREMENTS**

- DHD2 requires that a 4-foot test hole be excavated in the location of the proposed drainfield.
- If unable to dig the 4-foot hole, contact a DHD2 sanitarian to make arrangements for assistance.
- DHD2 will NOT drill test holes without clear markings of utility lines (eg. MISS DIG (811) sprinkler lines or other underground infrastructure).
- Property owner accepts all responsibility for damage that may occur as a result of DHD2 drilling test holes.
- All property lines must be clearly identified in situations where the proposed septic tank, drainfield or well will be within 50 feet of a property line.
- DHD2 reserves the right to require a survey of the property to determine property line locations if deemed necessary.
- Applicants must secure permission from neighboring property owners for DHD2 to access the property to measure distances from wells and/or septic system components to determine proper isolation distances.
- DHD2 staff will NOT enter neighboring properties without permission from the neighboring property owner.
- All buried well heads or wells inside structures on the applicant and neighboring properties must be identified.

**FAILURE TO MEET THE ABOVE CONDITIONS PRIOR TO THE ONSITE VISIT BY DHD2 STAFF COULD REQUIRE A REVISIT TO THE SITE AFTER CONDITIONS HAVE BEEN MET. IN THIS CASE AN ADDITIONAL VISIT FEE OF \$110 MAY BE ASSESSED.**

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
